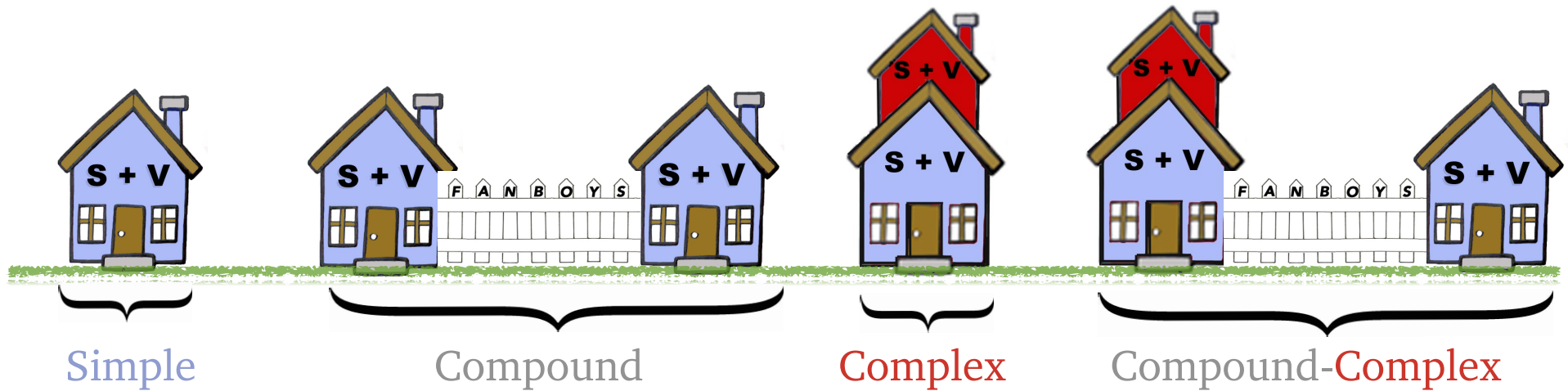


Structure Street



- **One** independent clause
- It expresses a complete thought.

- At least **two** independent clauses joined by a coordinating conjunction (FANBOYS)
- A comma usually is placed prior to the conjunction, unless the sentence is short and the clauses are closely related in thought.
- These clauses do not grammatically need one another and can stand alone.

- **One** independent clause
- At least one **dependent (subordinate)** clause

- The subordinate clause is set off with commas and begins with either a:
 - Subordinating conjunction (adverbial clause)
 - Relative pronoun (adjectival clause)

- At least **two** independent clauses
- At least one **dependent (subordinate)** clause
