What is a Bibliography? We want to give credit to our sources; it's a list of the resources we used to find the info on our topic. Why is it important that we cite our references? To give **validity** to the information we presented in our paper as well as **credit** to the sources we used.

chart on p. 161: core elements that the Bibliography should be include and in what order

Not every reference will have every element.

EXAMPLE: let's so an example together:

Crafting with Cat Hair: Cute Handicrafts to Make with Your Cat by Kaori Tsutaya Published by Quirk Books in Philadelphia, PA in 2011 54031st edition

Look at page 161 of SRP, and let's do this together:

Last, First. Book Title in Italics. Edition. Place of publication: Publishing company, publication date.

Tsutaya, Kaori. Crafting with Cat Hair. 54031st ed. Philadelphia: Quirk Books, 2011.

What order should your bibliography be in? Should it be in the order you used the source? Should it be in the order each source appears in your paper?

NO: It should be alphabetical.

page 134 in our USHBW book.

We need to alphabetize the six sources we used in these three paragraphs. If an author is not known, we use the title of the book or article in quotation marks. NOTE: if the title starts with "A," "an," or "the," we would ignore them.

Let's go through each source material and find either the author (if available or the title). I will write it on the board.

Newman, John J. and John H. Schmalbach (p. 134) - NOTICE how only the first author is last name first

Eibling, Harold H., John G. Gilman, and Anna Skehan (p.135)

"Alexander Graham Bell" - We have no author here, so we use the title of the article and put it in quotes (p.140) Again, if the title started with "A, an, or the" we would ignore them.

Biography.com Editors (p.141) - We italicize a website, I can not do it on the board, but I underline it to show that I should
