**The #3 -ly Adverb opener:** An easy way to do this if you're having a hard time coming up with a sentence, is to create a sentence with an -LY adverb, and then move the adverb to the beginning of the sentence.

For example: The children (quickly) built a snowman. Change it to: Quickly, the children built a snowman.
