## Notes to remember

Both the parent and the child are students! You are both learning together!

Copying the charts should take no more than 20 min each day - the goal is to memorize them, so find a method that works for your child.

The parent should read over the next chapter before class - so this week, you should be reading over week 3. Be sure to re-read if necessary - Chapter 3 is a big "game changer" in that we will be introducing the concept of the analytical tasks.

Review (copy) Chart B
Editing Exercise (sentences 13, 14) (pg 43)
Review week 2 homophones (pg 487), think of a sentence for each
Review week 2 spelling rule (pg 465); review flash card

Day 3
Copy Chart C (pg 402 & 403) - don't look! Work together to try to fill out as much of the chart as possible
Copy Chart D (pg 404 & 405) have student dictate the chart as parent does the writing
