***Because* Clause:**

This week's dress-up. Before we do a fun exercise, let's cover a few rules:

1. What is a clause? (*Has a subject and verb, but is not a complete sentence; it's an incomplete thought.*)

EXAMPLE: *Because Tayla knows karate,*

Sentence: *Tayla knows karate.*

2. It must be added to a sentence that is already complete.
3. It may be added before or after the complete sentence. Before = comma, after = no comma.

EXAMPLE: *Because Tayla knows karate, Ethan won't give Tayla a noogie.*

EXAMPLE: *Ethan won't give Tayla a noogie because Tayla knows karate.*

4. If we remove the "because," we should have two sentence.

Have the kids think of a place or item in the house that can be cleaned. I will write some suggestions on the board to spark their imagination: toilet, bedroom, doorknobs, fireplace, oven, etc. The stranger, the better.

Then, they will write on their whiteboards: I wasn't able to clean the _____ because

- * Go around the room and read out sentences.
- * Show them how the because clause can come first in a sentence (and requires a comma).

Then, they will dream up their own excuse and change their sentence to read:

Because ____<excuse>_____, I wasn't able to clean the _____.

Characters (Who)

Conflict (Why and What - What's happening; without this, the story is BORING!

CLIMAX - the point in the story where the Conflict is addressed or resolved

AFTER CLIMAX - the message or moral
